Supply List

1ea 10"X10"X1/2" Flat Board (Plywood). Used to make an Armature

1ea 12" long 3/8" thick wood dowel. Used to make an Armature

2ea Medium Plastic Bags

1 pkg wood skewer sticks

1ea Spray Water Bottle

Clay tools – to include; 1ea scraffitto tool or clean-up tool

Cone 10 Clay (25lbs)

1ea Apron

1ea 9X12 Sketch Pad

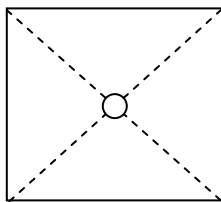
1 roll Masking Tape

1ea Sharpie Marker

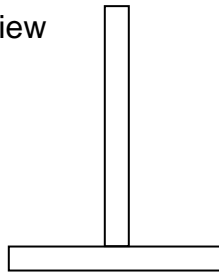
Armature

Note: *Drill 3/8" hole thru the center of the 10"x10"x 1/2" board, wrap end of dowel rod with masking tape and insert 12"x3/8" dowel rod into center hole. Make sure dowel is secure and tight.*
