

A52 - Understanding Color

- Acrylic paints (*please purchase professional quality paints like Liquitex or Golden, not student paints. Definitely DO NOT purchase any paints with the word "hue" in the title, i.e. "Cadmium Red Hue"*)
 - One tube warm red (Cadmium, Naphthol, or Pyrrol)
 - One tube cool red (Madder, Alizarin Crimson, or one of the Quinacridones)
 - One tube Pthalo Blue
 - One tube Ultramarine Blue
 - One tube Cadmium Yellow medium
 - One tube Cool Yellow (hansa light, azo light or medium)
 - One tube any black
 - One large tube any white
- One or two brushes: soft synthetic (Taklon is good), flat or bright, about ½" width
- Scotch removable tape, ¾" (This is the tape in the BLUE Scotch brand box, and you may have to get it from an office supply store, but be sure it is *removable*).
- Ruler
- Pencil
- Small spray bottle
- Hairdryer
- 4 pieces of mat board approx 14" x 20", any color (we will be using the white back side) (one sheet of mat board will yield these 4 pieces)

The student may wait until the first class before purchasing these supplies. It may be possible to share supplies with other students. Details will be given during the first class.
