**Paints** - You may either purchase a small set of pan watercolors (Winsor-Newton Cotman Sketchers' Pocket Box has the right colors, just need to replace the White with Indigo Blue) **OR** Tube paints (recommended brands are Winsor-Newton, Van Gogh, Cotman, Academy)

- Blues
  - Ultramarine or Cobalt
  - Phthalo Blue
  - Indigo
- Greens
  - Hooker's Green Dark or Viridian
  - Sap Green
- Yellows
  - Lemon Yellow
  - New Gamboge
  - Raw Sienna
- Reds
  - Cadmium Red Medium or Permanent Red
  - Alizaron Crimson
- Browns
  - Burnt Sienna
  - Burnt Umber or Raw Umber

### **Brushes**

- #12 round
- #6 round

**Paper** - 1 sheet each of:

- 140# Hot press watercolor paper
- 140# Cold press watercolor paper
- 140# Rough watercolor paper
- Pad of inexpensive watercolor paper

### **Other Supplies**

- Small spritz bottle
- Paper towels
- Water container
- Plastic palette for mixing paints and a storage palette if you have tube paints
- Brown packaging tape, the kind that needs to be wet (Meiningers)
- Masonite board (Also known as hardboard or MDF, approximately 18X24 and at least ¼ inch thick. You want the blonde colored board, NOT the dark brown. Home Depot will cut this, usually for free!)

*Supplies will cost approximately \$75. Materials can be purchased at Meiningers, Art Hardware, Michaels, Hobby Lobby, and Aaron Brothers. If you are unsure of what to purchase, call me. Please bring supplies with you, we will be painting.*
