- Watercolor paper (good quality 140/200lb.)
- Watercolor paints & palette (Reeves or any beginner set will do...tubes only!)
- Brushes: medium size round and 1 ½" round to begin...(buy the best you can afford....PLEASE NO packaged school brushes)
- Old towel to paint on
- Salt
- Masking fluid (be careful...DON'T get permanent)
- Rubber cement pickup
- Spray bottle

Any other supplies will be discussed during first class or call with questions.

Invest in the highest quality supplies that you can afford. Art supply stores or craft stores often accept coupons. Using professional supplies can make a tremendous difference in the quality of painting you create!
