

A60 - Colorful Watercolors

- 24"x32" piece of ½ in plywood (taples must go in it) \$7.00-up
 - Add handle or cut hole for handle
- Small Staple gun and matching SIZE of Staples \$12.00
- Bath towel (from home)
- 3 sheets D'Arches 140# rough watercolor paper (not a pad) \$5.00 each
- 1" Natural bristle brush \$ 1.00-\$20.00
- 4-5 various sizes of watercolor brushes including a # 10 round and a small detail brush \$varies
- Old Toothbrush
- Natural sponge \$2.00-\$3.00
- Exacto knife/ #11 blades \$3.00 + blades
- Plastic wrap (saran, etc)
- Salt
- ½ in. roll Drafting tape (not "art tape" or masking tape) \$4.59
- Liquid Mask (Misk-it or Frisket) \$4.00 – up
- Small bottle of black ink (India, drawing)
- Plastic watercolor palette \$1.00-\$10.00
- Tubes of watercolors \$2.50- up
 - Less expensive student grade Brands- (Grumbacher Academy, Winsor Newton Cotman, or Van Gogh)
 - Required Colors:
 - Alizerian Crimson or Rose Madder
 - Cadmium Red Medium
 - Cadmium Yellow Light
 - Prussian Blue or Thalo blue
 - Ultramarine blue
 - Chinese white
 - You may buy other colors: purples, greens, etc.

Prices are based on purchases from Meinengers; some of these items may be bought elsewhere- craft stores, etc. Pre packaged sets of watercolors may not have these same colors, and other brands of paper may not hold up to masking.

PLEASE ATTEND THE 1ST CLASS FOR PAPER STRETCHING DEMONSTRATION. FROM THEN ON, BRING PAPER ALREADY STRETCHED, DRY, AND READY TO PAINT.
