

## A66 – Irises in Watercolor

Instructor: Martha Kisling

Bring any watercolor paints, paper and brushes that you have.

If you need to buy *new*, this is what I recommend:

- Paints - buy watercolor paints in tubes. Reeves sells basic sets (\$10)
- Brushes – mid size round (#10, 12 or 14), 1 inch flat (liner or script brush optional) Loew-Cornell 7000 series are good, inexpensive brushes (less than \$10 each)
- Paper – Arches 140 lb. cold press (not hot) large 22”x 30” sheets work the best. Paper in a tablet does not work as well!!!! Large sheets can be cut down to smaller sizes. (\$5-\$8 /sheet)
- Palette – a large plastic palette with paint wells around the outside and a big mixing area works best for watercolor. (\$10-\$14)
- Large container for water
- Paper towels
- Pencil and eraser
