CRAY PAS STUDENT GRADE OIL PASTELS (with number: I have turned in the list at Meiningers: if you call ahead they will put the pack together for you. You can use Holbein also.

Price: under \$1. each)

Lemon Yellow-XLP#2, Yellow-XLP#3, Deep Yellow-XLP#4

Orange- #XLP5

Vermilion Hue-XLP#18, Red-XLP#19, *Holbein* #14 Crimson Lake (better color)

Violet XLP#23

Cerulean Blue-XLP#25, Ultramarine Blue-XLP#28, Cobalt Blue (true blue)-XLP#36

Green-XLP#29

White-XLP50, Black-XLP49

Gray-XLP-44, Dark Gray-XLP144

OPTIONAL: Prussian Blue-#XLP43, Dark Rose-#XLP122

(Note: Professional grade has more pigment saturation but is also more expensive.)

Paper: Also at Meininger's: Strathmore Bristol 400 series: either Vellum or Smooth: refer to SHELF #56. (Price: under \$3.00.) Chart will be 20" round, plus room for notes, color patches, and cross-reference to Goethe's Color Triangle.

Brushes: #4 flat or filbert bristle, #2 filbert bristle; #4 watercolor round (synthetic bristle).

Rag or paper towels

#2 pencil and white eraser

Small closed container (baby food jar)

Odorless mineral spirits

FOR THE PAINTING:

Your medium of choice to include the colors listed above, and your usual supplies:

For oils/acrylics, bring usual materials including palette knife for mixing colors;
Also for oils, odor-free mineral spirits and closed jar to take home used solvent.

Appropriate support: Watercolor paper, Pastel paper, drawing paper, canvas, canvas board
(or gessoed masonite)

Brushes:

- Watercolor - Watercolor brushes #6 & 10 rounds; ½" flat.
- Oils & Acrylics - #4 and #6 filberts and brights - and small rounds.

****Also bring what you have.*

Please check our studio assignment. I will request the Intermediate Studio (Tables, no easels). If you prefer working with an easel for the painting, please bring.

Always include sketchbook, #2 pencil, eraser, paint rags – whatever you usually use.

New students can continue the afternoon work with the oil pastels and drawing paper (*I like large spiral-bound sketchbooks, 11x14 or larger*).

Other supplies can be purchased at Meininger's, Hobby Lobby or Michaels. Always check Hobby Lobby weekly coupon, very useful for sketchbooks, student canvases, brushes, etc.
