

D9 - Short Shorts: A Mini Film Class

Supplies:

- Video Camera –You will need access to a video camera that you will use for your film projects and bring with you to class. Your camera can be absolutely anything that records – people have made successful movies on everything from a cell-phone camera to the RED One camera and everything in between.
- Recording Medium –You will need whatever your camera uses to record: VHS tapes, mini DV tapes, SD cards, etc.
- Notebook, Binder, or Laptop – You will need a film log, something you'll use for taking notes and planning your film structure and shoot schedule.
- *Optional* Editing Software – Although it's not necessary to the class (you can "edit in camera"), if you do have Final Cut Pro, iMovie, or other digital editing software we will devote final classes to editing issues, go over the basics of using this tool in your filmmaking, help you troubleshoot, etc.

We will also review books and movies you may find useful for reference, and we will look at several during the class, but none are required supplies. Estimated cost - \$20 (assuming you already have the video camera you will use for class).
